## The Scientific Martyrs of Lorestan Province

- Kazemi Gol Baghi, Nematullah: He was born on the 6<sup>th</sup> of Mordad 1343 (1964/7/28) in Delfan County in Lorestan province. He was the son of Shahmorad and Sogra. He was a Ph.D. student in medicine. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 5th of Shahrivar 1362 (1983/8/27), he was shot by Iraqi forces in Marivan and was martyred. His grave is located in the paradise of Zahra (Behesht-e-Zahra) in his hometown. His brother, Mohammad Gholi, was also martyred.
- 2. Gol Khatu Nabati, Niaz Ali: He was born on the 18th of Mehr 1342 (1963/10/10) in Delfan County. He was the son of Nour Ali and Tala. He earned a bachelor's degree in economics. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 27<sup>th</sup> of Bahman 1364 (1986/2/16), he was martyred when he was hit in his head by shrapnel in Arvand Roud. His grave is located in the paradise of Zahra (Behesht-e-Zahra) in his hometown.
- 3. Bagheri, Abulqasem: He was born on the 24th of Tir 1344 (1365/7/15) in Azna. His father, Mohammad Bagher, worked in an oil company. His mother's name was Nazi. He was an undergraduate student of the French language. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. He was shot and martyred on the 19th Esfand 1365 (1987/3/10) in Shalamcheh. He was buried in his hometown. His brothers, Mahmoud and Mohammad Nabi, were also martyred.
- 4. Bagheri, Mohammad Nabi: He was born on the 24th of Tir 1346 (1967-7-15) in Azna. His father, Mohammad Bagher, worked in an oil company. His mother's name was Nazi. He was a Bachelor's student of physics. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 4<sup>th</sup> of

Tir 1367 (1988/6/25), he was captured by the Iraqi forces. On the 10th of that month, he was martyred by shrapnel in Majnoon Island. He was buried in his hometown after the exchange of Iran-Iraq prisoners.

- 5. Jadid al-Islami, Abdul Reza: He was born on the 3rd of Mehr 1344 (1965/9/25) in Cheshmeh Dargah, a village in Azna County. His father, Hassan, was a farmer and his mother's name was Mah Sultan. He was an undergraduate student. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. He was martyred on the 28th of Ordibehesht 1365 (1986/5/18) in Haj Imran, Iraq. He was buried in his hometown.
- 6. Piriyaei, Mohammad Sadegh: He was born on the 2nd of Farvardin 1344 (1965/3/22) in Tambak, as a village in Azna County. His father was Hassan and his mother was Bessie. He was an associate student. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front lines. On the 25<sup>th</sup> of Ordibehesht 1365 (1986/5/15) in Haj Imran in Iraq, he was shot and martyred. He was buried in his hometown.
- 7. Hajivand, Abbas: He was born on the 1st of Dey 1344 (1965/12/22) in Dorud. His father, Ali, was a worker. His mother's name was Sedigheh. He was an undergraduate student in psychology and worked as a teacher. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 2th of Khordad 1365 (1986/5/23), he was martyred in Haj Imran, Iraq, he was buried in Azna.
- Tavakkoli, Ali Akbar: He was born on the 10th of Bahman 1338 (1960/1/31) in the village of Marzian in Azna County. His father's name was Ezzatullah and his mother's name was Robabeh. He was an undergraduate student. As a soldier of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard

Corps, he went to the front. On the 5<sup>th</sup> of Mordad 1360 (1981/7/27), he was martyred by shrapnel in Susangerd. He was buried in his hometown.

- 9. Mahmoudi, Ali: He was born on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Farvardin 1344 (1965/3/21) in Aligudarz. His father, Mehdi, was a bookseller. His mother's name was Robabeh. He was a Master's student in metallurgy. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 4th of Farvardin 1367 (1988/3/24), as a RPG shooter in Shakh Shemiran, he was shot and martyred by Iraqi forces. His grave is in Akbar Ali cemetery in his hometown.
- 10. Valian, Alireza: He was born on the 19th of Mehr 1337 (1958/10/11) in Aligudarz. His father, Karim, sold building materials and his mother's name was Kobra. He was a Ph.D. student in pharmacy. He got married in 1362 (1983). He had a daughter. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 30th of Ordibehesht 1365 (1986/5/20), as the company commander, he was martyred in Haj Imran, Iraq. His body remained in the region for a while. In 1373 (1994), he was buried in the central cemetery of his hometown.
- 11. Jaber Ansari, Ali: He was born on the 1th of Ordibehesht 1345 (1966/4/21) in Borujerd. His father was Nadali, who was a farmer and his mother was Efat. He was a second year medical student. On the 2nd of Bahman 1365 (1987/1/22), he was martyred in the aerial bombardment of his hometown after becoming trapped in debris. His grave is located in Borujerd.
- 12. Hatami, Ali Mohammad: He was born on the 17th of Khordad 1345 (1966/6/7) in Pol-e Dokhtar. His father, Ali Morad, was a farmer and his mother was Narges. He was an

undergraduate agriculture student. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 24th of Mordad 1364 (1985/8/15), as an expert sniper in Changuleh, he was martyred by the Iraqi forces. His grave is located in his hometown.

- 13. Joodaki, Ali: He was born on the 18th of Tir 1347 (1968/7/9) in Pol-e Dokhtar. His father, Asa, was a farmer. His mother was Zahra. He was a Master's student in theology and Islamic studies. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 5th of Tir 1367 (1988/6/26), as one of the artillery unit members in Shakh Shemiran, he was martyred by a stray bullet. He was buried in his hometown.
- 14. Rostampour, Mansour Ali: He was born on the 1st of Mehr 1342 (1963/9/23) in the village of Rashnoo in Kuhdasht. His father, Mousa, was a farmer and his mother was Nazar Tala. He was an associate student and worked as a teacher. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 11th of Farvardin 1365 (1986/3/31), he got martyred in Sulaymaniyah, Iraq. His body remained in the region for a long time. On the 9<sup>th</sup> of Ordibehesht 1380 (2001/4/29), he was buried in his hometown.
- 15. Hosseinpour, Ali Abbas: He was born in the 30<sup>th</sup> of Mordad 1345 (1966/8/6) in Khorramabad. His father was Jomeh and his mother was La Banoo. He was a second-year theology student. As a conscript soldier, he went to the front. He was martyred on the 23rd of Bahman 1364 (1986/2/12) in Al-Faw, Iraq, when he was hit in the head by shrapnel. He was buried in the paradise of Zahra (Behesht-e-Zahra) in his hometown.

- 16. Derikvand, Nazar Ali: He was born on the 1st of Azar 1344 (1965/11/22) in the village of Darai in Khorramabad. His father was Hashem and his mother was Shaznan. He was a second-year student at Teacher Training University and worked as a teacher. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 11th of Farvardin 1365 (1986/3/31), he was martyred when he was shot in Sulaymaniyah, Iraq. His grave is located in his hometown.
- 17. Zivdar, Omid Ali: He was born on the 13th of Esfand 1342 (1964/3/3) in Khorramabad. His father was Ali and his mother was Mama. He was a second-year student in teacher training. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 15<sup>th</sup> of Farvardin 1365 (1986/4/4), he was martyred by the Iraqi forces in Shakh Shemiran. The remains of his body found after being found on the 28<sup>th</sup> of Mordad 1372 (1993/8/19) were buried in his hometown.
- 18. Shafiei Najafi, Seyyed Alireza: He was born on the 5th of Esfand (1967/2/24) 1345 in a village in Aleshtar. His father was Seyyed Fazel, who was a worker and his mother was Fanoos. He was as associate student, who worked as a teacher. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 19th of Dey 1366 (1988/1/9), he was martyred in Maoot region in Iraq when he was hit in the shoulder, face and knee by shrapnel. He was buried in the martyrs' cemetery in Khorramabad.
- 19. Goodarzi, Ali: He was born on the 1st of Khordad 1330 (1951/5/23), in Veysian, Khorramabad. His father Baba Hossein was a carpenter and his mother was Kafieh. He held a diploma in mathematics. Also, he was a seminary student. On the 27th of Mordad 1357 (1978/8/18), during the protests against the Pahlavi regime in his hometown, he was martyred because of a blow to his head. He was buried in his hometown.

- 20. Morad Alivand, Ali Mohammad: He was born on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Tir 1342 (1963/6/22) in Pol-e Dokhtar. His father was Lotf Ali and his mother was Agha Nazar. He completed an associate's degree and was a teacher. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 2nd of Khordad 1365 (1986/5/23), he was martyred in Haj Imran, Iraq, when a shot hit him in the back. His grave in the martyrs' cemetery in Khorramabad.
- 21. Tavakkoli, Bahram: He was born on the 7th of Farvardin 1344 (1965/3/27) in Ashraf Abad, a village in Azna. His father, Mashallah, was a farmer and his mother was Kobra. He was an undergraduate student in psychology. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 12<sup>th</sup> of Khordad 1365 (1986/6/2), as a medical assistant, he was martyred in Al-Faw, Iraq. He was buried in his hometown. His brother, Mansour, was also martyred
- 22. Varmazyar, Ali: He was born on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of Mordad 1346 (1967/7/25) in Azna. His father, Abbas, was a shopkeeper and his mother was Sedigheh. He was a second year associate's student. On 30<sup>th</sup> of Shahrivar 1366 (1987/9/21), he was martyred in the aerial bombardment of his hometown when he was hit in his heart by shrapnel. His grave is located in his hometown.
- 23. Asgari, Ezzatolah: He was born on the 5th of Farvardin 1343 (1964/3/25) in Bagh Muri, a village in the central district of Azna County. His father, Alishah, was a farmer, and his mother was Javaher. He was an associate student. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 6<sup>th</sup> of Mordad 1367 (1988/7/28), he was martyred in Shalamcheh after being hit by shrapnel. His grave is located in Eslamshahr.

- 24. Mahdavikia, Ghader: He was born on the 2nd of Bahman 1350 (1972/1/22) in Aligudarz. His father was Haji Baba (died in 1364) and his mother was Aroos. He was an associate student. He got married in 1374 (1996). On the 30<sup>th</sup> of Shahrivar 1366 (1987/9/21), he was injured in the aerial bombardment of Azna. On the 17th of Khordad 1379 (2000/6/6), he was martyred in Khorramabad because of the complications caused by the injuries. His grave is located in Azna.
- 25. Velian, Gholam Abbas: He was born on the 8th of Azar 1344 (1965/11/29) in Tehran. His father, Mohammad Ali, was a worker in the oil company and his mother was Ghadamkheir. He was an undergraduate student. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 19th of Tir 1367 (1988/7/10), he was martyred by being hit by Iraqi forces in Baneh.. His grave is located in the central cemetery in Aligudarz.
- 26. Hashemi, Seyyed Mohsen: He was born on the 6<sup>th</sup> of Khordad 1346 (1967/5/27) in Aligudarz. His father, Seyyed Hasan, was a salesman and his mother was Sekineh. He was an undergraduate student. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 19th of Tir 1367 (1988/7/10), he was martyred in Baneh by Iraqi forces when he was hit by shrapnel. His grave is located in the central cemetery of his hometown.
- 27. Jokar, Mohammad Hossein: He was born on the 22nd of Tir 1346 (1967/7/13) in Tehran. His father Hassan Ali was a worker and his mother was Sedigheh. He was an undergraduate student in civil engineering. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 22nd of Dey1365 (1987/1/12), he was martyred in Shalamcheh after being hit by shrapnel. His grave is located in the martyrs' cemetery in Tiran, a village in the central district of Aligudarz County.

- 28. Karimi, Fathullah: He was born on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of Tir 1335 (1956/6/24) in the village of Gandomineh, a village in the central district of Aligudarz County. His father, Valiollah, was a farmer and his mother was Belgheis. He was an undergraduate student. On the 6th of Dey 1357 (1978/12/27), while participating in the protests against the Pahlavi regime in Tehran, he was martyred by a bullet. His grave is located in the paradise of Zahra (Behesht-e-Zahra) in his hometown. He was also called Yadollah.
- 29. Ahmadi, Mohammad Hassan: He was born on the 25th of Aban 1341 (1962/11/16) in Aligudarz. His father, Yadollah, was a bricklayer and his mother was Farangis. He was an undergraduate student in industrial engineering and was a guardsman. He got married in 1361 and had three daughters. On the 5<sup>th</sup> of Mordad 1367 (1988/7/27), as a commander in Kermanshah, he was martyred during the conflict with anti-revolutionary groups after being hit in the eye and heart by shrapnel. His grave is located in the central cemetery of his hometown.
- 30. Goodarzi, Mohsen: He was born on the 30<sup>th</sup> of Aban 1356 (1977/11/21) in Aligudarz. His father was Habibollah, who was a grocer and his mother was Sekineh. He finished his bachelor's degree in military sciences and tactics. He was an air force lieutenant and a flight instructor. On the 26th of Bahman 1379 (2001/2/14), in the military barracks, he was martyred in a helicopter crash during the training flight. His grave is in the central cemetery in his hometown.
- 31. Musivand, Saadi: He was born on the 10<sup>th</sup> of Dey 1342 (1963/12/31) in Borujerd. His father,
  Noor Mohammad, was a salesman and his mother was Nazbanoo. He was an undergraduate

student in economics. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 15th of Tir 1365 (1986/7/6), he was martyred in Mehran by Iraqi forces when he was hit in the shoulder by shrapnel. His grave is located in martyrs' cemetery in his hometown.

- 32. Bahraniani, Abdul Zahra: He was born on the 19th of Khordad 1344 (1965/6/9) in Abadan. His father, Nozar, was an oil company worker and his mother was Zahra. He was an undergraduate student in chemistry. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 15<sup>th</sup> of Mordad 1364 (1985/8/6), he was martyred in Zubeidat, Iraq, by being hit by shrapnel. His grave is located in Borujerd.
- 33. Choobkar, Mohammad: He was born on the 10th of Shahrivar 1339 (1960/9/1) in Borujerd. His father, Muhammad Ali, was a wood seller and his mother was Robabeh. He was a final year medical student. He got married in 1360 (1981) and had two daughters. He went to the front as a member from the Islamic revolutionary guard corps. On the 30<sup>th</sup> of Khordad 1367 (1988/6/20), when he worked as a health center's officer in Mehran, he was martyred by the Iraqi forces as a result of being hit in the leg. He was buried in his hometown.
- 34. Ohadi, Mohammad Hossein: He was born on the 18th of Bahman 1337 (1959/2/7) in Borujerd. His father, Mohammad Kazem, had a job in the Ministry of Education and his mother was Sedigheh. He was an undergraduate student in mechanical engineering. He got married in 1360 (1981). He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 18th of Bahman 1361 (1983/2/7), he was martyred in Reghabieh when he was hit by shrapnel. His grave is in the martyrs' cemetery in his hometown.

- 35. Bermal, Mohammad: He was born on the 8<sup>th</sup> of Shahrivar 1343 (1964/8/30) in Pol-e Dokhtar. His father, Seyyed Mohammad, was a farmer and his mother was Maryam. He was a teacher training student. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 27th of Khordad 1367 (1988/6/17), he was martyred as a gunner in Qomish when he was hit by the bullet. His body remained in the area for a long time. When his body was found, he was buried in his hometown.
- 36. Abbasi Garavand, Mohammad Alim: He was born on the 30<sup>th</sup> of Khordad 1343 (1964/6/20) in Kuhdasht. His father was an employee and his mother was Gohartaj. He was a doctoral student in medicine. He got married and had a daughter. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 1st of Bahman 1365 (1987/1/21) in Shalamcheh, he was martyred by shrapnel. His grave is located in his hometown. He was also called Shahram.
- 37. Hashemi, Mohammad Behrouz: He was born on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Bahman 1347 (1969/1/21) in the village of Peresk in Aleshtar. His father, Mohammad, was a teacher and his mother was Kobra. He was an associate student in teacher training. He was also a teacher. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 31st of Farvardin 1364 (1985/4/20), as a RPG shooter, he was martyred by shrapnel in the Zaid outpost in Iraq. His grave is located in his hometown.
- 38. Golpayegani, Fariduddin: He was born on the 27th of Mordad 1340 (1961/8/18) in Borujerd. His father, Masoud, was an employee and his mother was Maloos. He was an undergraduate student in educational sciences. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 3rd of Esfand 1362 (1984/2/22), as a sniper in Chazabeh, he was martyred when he was hit in the head. His grave is located in the martyrs' cemetery in his hometown. He was also called Mohsen.

- 39. Khosravi, Iraj: He was born on the 21st of Azar 1338 (1959/12/13) in Borujerd. His father, Ahmad, worked in the municipality and his mother was Nosrat. He was a Ph.D. student in medicine. He was an officer. He went to the front as a member of the Iranian Army. On the 3rd of Farvardin 1361 (1982/3/23), as a health center's commander, he was martyred in Reghabieh as a result of being hit by shrapnel. His body was buried in the martyrs' cemetery in his hometown. He was also called Abdullah.
- 40. Norouzian, Mustafa: He was born on the 4<sup>th</sup> of Khordad 1341 (1962/5/25) in Borujerd. His father, Mashallah, was a grocer and his mother was Molouk. He got an associate's degree in teacher training. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 29th of Dey 1365 (1987/1/19), as a battalion's deputy commander, he was martyred in Shalamcheh when he was hit in the face by shrapnel. His grave is in the martyrs' cemetery in his hometown.
- 41. Mishani Fard, Nader: He was born on the 20th of Tir 1340 (1961/7/11) in Abadan. His father, Gholamreza, worked in the oil company. His mother was Eshrat. He was an undergraduate student in political sciences. He got married in 1363 (1984). He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 4<sup>th</sup> of Dey 1365 (1986/12/25), as an ammunition technical officer in Shalamcheh, he was martyred by shrapnel after a mine explosion. He was buried in the martyrs' cemetery in Borujerd. His brother, Khosrow, was also martyred.
- 42. Hosseini, Ahmad: He was born on the 31st of Khordad 1344 (1965/6/21) in Borujard. His father, Shokrullah, was a cleric and his mother was Ezzat. He was an undergraduate student in electrical engineering. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 24th of Mordad

1365 (1986/8/15), as a telecommunication officer, he was martyred in Al-Faw in Iraq when he was hit in the head by shrapnel. His grave is located in his hometown.

- 43. Dehghani, Ebrahim: He was born on the 22th of Esfand 1334 (1956/3/13) in Abadan. His father was Abul Hasan and his mother was Roghayeh. He was a doctoral student in medicine. He got married in 1358 (1979) and had a son. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 12th of Ordibehesht 1361 (1982/5/2), as a distribution officer, he was martyred in Darkhoveyn when he was hit in the stomach by shrapnel. He was buried in Borujerd.
- 44. Pajoohandeh, Gholam Hossein: He was born on the 1<sup>st</sup> of Dey 1338 (1959/12/23) in Borujerd. His father was Saifullah and his mother was Khanum. He was an undergraduate student in physics. As a soldier of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps, he went to the front. On the 8th Ordibehesht 1360 (1981/4/28), as the unit officer, he was martyred by the bullet from an anti-revolutionary group that made an attempt on his life in Ahvaz. His grave is located in his hometown.
- 45. Beiranvand, Abdolreza: He was born on the 30<sup>th</sup> of Farvardin 1345 (1966/4/19) in Boz-e Azna, a village in the central district of Borujerd County. His father, Alireza, was a farmer and his mother was Qamar. He was an undergraduate student. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 21st of Tir 1365 (1986/7/11), he was martyred in Majnoon Island in Iraq, when he was hit by shrapnel. His grave is located in his hometown.
- 46. Pourmohsan, Hossein: He was born on the 18th of Tir 1338 (1959/7/10) in Borujard. His father, Hassan, was a driver and his mother was Sedigheh. He was an undergraduate student in mechanical engineering. As a member of the Basij, he went to the front. On the 10th of

Shahrivar 1362 (1983/9/1), he was martyred by shrapnel in Zaid outpost in Iraq. His grave is located in his hometown.

- 47. Shahkarami, Habibullah: He was born on the 20th of Shahrivar 1343 (1964/9/11) in Borujerd. His father, Karim, was a worker and his mother's name was Batool. He was an undergraduate student in primary education and he worked in the Ministry of Education. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 26th of Dey 1365 (1987/1/16) in Shalamcheh, he was martyred when he was hit in the hand and side. His grave is located in the martyrs' cemetery in his hometown.
- 48. Ghorsban Rouzbahani, Mohsen: He was born on the 2nd of Tir 1347 (1968/6/23) in Borujerd. His father's name was Ali and his mother's name was Mahin Banoo. He was a student of political sciences at Imam Sadiq University. He went to the front, as a member of the Basij. On the 20th of Farvardin 1366 (1987/8/10), as a paramedic, he was martyred in Shalamcheh, when he was hit in his leg and head by shrapnel. His grave is located in the martyrs' cemetery in his hometown.
- 49. Moazami Goodarzi, Teymour: He was born on the 15th of Farvardin 1340 (1961/4/4) in Malmijan, a village in Borujerd County. His father, Ali, was a farmer and his mother's name was Fatemeh. He was a teacher training student. He got married. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. He was martyred by being hit in the head by shrapnel in Haj Imran, Iraq. His body remained in the region for a long time. In 1373 (1994), he was buried in the martyrs' cemetery in his hometown.

50. Moltamesi, Abdullah: He was born on the 29th of Esfand 1337 (1959/3/20) in Borujerd. His father, Gholamreza, was a bank clerk and his mother's name was Aghdas. He was a Master's student in electronics. He got married and had a son. He went to the front as a member of the Basij. On the 28th of Aban 1362 (1983/11/19), he was martyred by shrapnel from the Iraqi forces. His grave is in the paradise of Zahra (Behesht-e-Zahra) in his hometown.
